This is the poem that will be placed in our class anthology. Select or write one of your own poems to read to the class. Be sure to have a clean copy. You may share any background information (when & why it was written) about your poem. Be sure to practice reading all of the poems & information you are going to share! You may want to ask me about any tricky words you come across. You will want to do this BEFORE it is your day to
